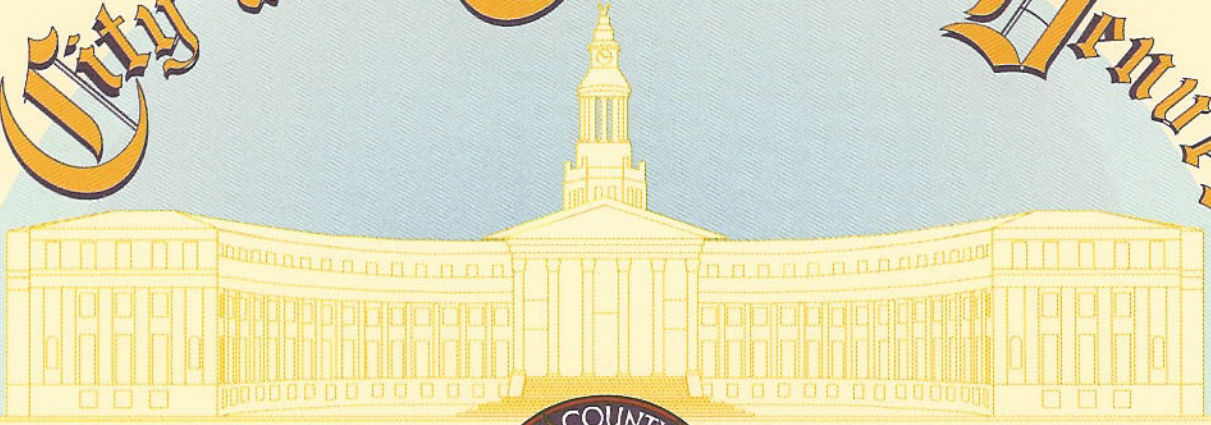


# City and County of Denver
