- WHEREAS, The citizens of Denver possess the confidence and commitment to meet the new challenges we now face with creativity as well as with resoluteness; and
- WHEREAS, The citizens of Denver acknowledge the importance of our families in maintaining a strong community and celebrate the ways in which we have reached out to one another since that day three years ago; and
- WHEREAS, The citizens of Denver seek to build a place for people to come together in peace in this city, for a world that leaves a legacy of hope and cooperation to our children, our grandchildren, and our great-grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS, The Imagine Peace Foundation and the Peace Journey Foundation have stepped forward to hold A Celebration of Peace Festival and Concert at Red Rocks in order to create a higher awareness of peace in our daily lives.
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN W. HICKENLOOPER, MAYOR, of the City and County of Denver, Colorado, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby officially proclaim September 11, 2004 to be known as:

"A DAY OF APPRECIATION AND PEACE IN DENVER, COLORADO"
